UNION CABINET APPROVES A CONTRACT UNDER BUY (INDIAN-IDDM) CATEGORY

- Union Cabinet accorded approval to sign a contract with Larsen & Toubro Limited (L&T) for acquisition of three Cadet Training Ships under Buy (Indian-IDDM) category of Defence Acquisition Policy 2020 (DAP).
- Salient features of DAP 2020:
 - Notification of positive indigenisation lists in respect of weapons/platforms.
 - Increased Indigenous Content (IC) in various categories of procurement.
 - **Highest priority** to procurement under Buy (Indian-IDDM) category.
 - Reservation for MSMEs and small shipyards for orders up to Rs 100 crore/year.
- About Buy {Indian-IDDM (Indigenously Designed, Developed and Manufactured)} category.
 - It refers to acquisition of products from an Indian vendor that have a minimum of 50% Indigenous Content on cost basis of the base contract price i.e. total contract price less taxes and duties.

1.	Buy (Indian-IDDM)	Indigenous design and ≥ 50%
2.	Buy (Indian)	In case of indigenous design ≥ 50%, otherwise≥ 60%
3.	Buy and Make (Indian)	≥ 50% of the 'Make' portion
4.	Buy (Global - Manufacture in India)	≥ 50%
5.	Buy (Global)	Foreign Vendor –Nil Indian Vendor ≥ 30%

- > It is one among five procurement categories (refer infographic) under Defence Acquisition Procedure (DAP) 2020.
- > DAP 2020 superseded Defence Procurement Procedure (DPP) of 2016.

INDIA HOSTS THE FIRST MEETING OF GOVERNING BOARD OF BIMSTEC ENERGY CENTRE (BEC)

- It recommended the addition of cyber security, green hydrogen, and energy transition areas under the specialized wings of BEC.
- About BEC
 - The First BIMSTEC Energy Ministers Conference of 2005, agreed to the setting up of a BEC to share experience in reforms, restructuring, regulation, and best practices in the energy sector.
 - **> Objectives of the Centre:** create, manage, and evaluate energy-related databases to suggest a road map for meaningful intra-BIMSTEC cooperation.
- Initiatives for BIMSTEC Energy Cooperation
 - > The grid interconnection MoU, signed in 2018 by member-states, for the trade in electricity with optimal power transmission in the BIMSTEC region.
 - > The **1125 MW Dorjilung hydropower project involving Bangladesh, Bhutan, and India** will allow Bhutan to export electricity to Bangladesh through India.
- About BIMSTEC
 - > Genesis: It is a regional organization that was established on 06 June 1997 with the signing of the Bangkok Declaration.
 - > Objective: To foster regional and economic cooperation.
 - Member countries: 7 member nations in the littoral and adjacent areas of the Bay of Bengal — India, Thailand, Myanmar, Nepal, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, and Bhutan.
 - > Current Chair: Thailand and its secretariat is situated in Dhaka, Bangladesh.

A NEW REPORT HIGHLIGHTED LINK BETWEEN SPACE WEATHER AND FLIGHT DELAYS

- A new study published in journal Nature Scientific Reports highlighted:
- > Average arrival delay time during space weather events rose by 81.34 per cent compared to quieter periods.
- > It interferes with communication and navigation, which are crucial in managing modern air traffic and ensuring safety.
- About Space Weather: It describes the variations in the space environment between the sun and Earth. Key terms related to space weather
 - Solar wind: They continuously flow outward from the Sun and consists mainly of protons and electrons in a state known as a plasma.
 - Coronal Mass Ejections (CMEs): Large expulsions of plasma and magnetic field from the Sun's corona (outermost layer of Sun).
 - Geomagnetic storms: They are fluctuations in the Earth's magnetic field, caused by changes in the solar wind and interplanetary magnetic field.
 - > Sunspots: Areas where the magnetic field is about 2,500 times stronger than Earth's, much higher than anywhere else on the Sun.
 - A typical spot consists of a dark region called the umbra, surrounded by a lighter region known as the penumbra.
 - Sunspots increase and decrease through an average cycle of 11 years (Solar cycle)

CONSTITUTION OF GREATER PANNA LANDSCAPE COUNCIL (GPLC)


- As part of the **Ken-Betwa Link Project (KBLP)**, GPLC has been constituted to ensure systematic and time bound implementation of the **Greater Panna Landscape Management plan**.
 - > KBLP is an interlinking of rivers project (through the Panna Tiger Reserve), envisages transferring water from the Ken River to the Betwa river.
- The broad objectives of the GPLC are;
 - > Enable betterment of habitat, and management for flagship species viz. tiger, vulture, and gharial in the landscape;
 - Consolidate the landscape for biodiversity conservation through spatial prioritization;
 - > Provide species-specific and site-specific monitoring strategies.
- About Integrated Landscape Management
 - > It refers to long term collaboration to achieve the objectives required from the landscape, such as agricultural production, the delivery of ecosystem services, cultural heritage and values, and rural livelihoods.
- About Panna Tiger Reserve
 - > Location: It is situated in the Vindhyan Hills nearer to the confluence of the Deccan Peninsula, Upper Gangetic Plain, and Semi-Arid Gujarat Rajputana reflecting the influence of three bio-geographic regions.
 - > Major River: Ken Passes through it.
 - > Formation: It was formed in 1981 and in 2011 it was designated a biosphere reserve by the government.
 - It is the 3rd Biosphere Reserve included in the World Network of Biosphere reserves (WNBR) from Madhya Pradesh after Pachmarhi and Amarkantak.

SUPREME COURT'S OBSERVATIONS WITH RESPECT TO ANTI-DEFECTION LAW

- SC has observed that for application of **anti-defection law**, it does not matter whether rival group is the **minority or majority within the political party** if their acts amount **to defection**.
- About Anti-Defection law:
 - > It was added by the 52nd Amendment in 1985 that also inserted Tenth Schedule to the Constitution (grounds of defection).
 - > A member of a House becomes disqualified if:
 - He voluntarily gives up his membership of such political party; or
 - He votes/abstains from voting contrary to any direction issued by his political party and such act has not been condoned by the party within 15 days.
 - An independent member becomes disqualified he joins any political party after such election.
 - A nominated member becomes disqualified if he joins any political party after expiry of six months from date on which he takes seat.

> Exceptions in anti-defection law:

- Allows a party to merge with or into another party provided at least two-thirds of its legislators are in favour.
- If a person is elected as speaker of Lok Sabha or Chairman of Rajya Sabha then he could resign from his party, and rejoin the party once he demits that post.

다. 유민이 Raisina Dialogue 2023	 It is a multilateral conference committed to addressing the most challenging issues facing the global community, held annually in New Delhi since 2016. It takes its name from Raisina Hill- the seat of the Indian government. It is hosted by the Observer Research Foundation in collaboration with the Ministry of External Affairs. It brings together global leaders in policy, business, media, civil society, defence and foreign policy. 	
Fugitive economic offenders Act 2018	 India called upon G-20 Nations to adopt multilateral action for faster extradition of fugitive economic offenders (FEO) and recovery of assets both on the domestic front and abroad. Government has enacted the FEO Act 2018, to deal with FEOs. It defines offender as who; has left India to avoid criminal prosecution; or being abroad refuses to return to India to face criminal prosecution; an arrest warrant has been issued against him for any specified offenses where the value involved is over Rs 100 crore. 	
Advance Authorisation Scheme	 Recently, the Director General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) further simplified the process of Composition Fee for Export Obligation Extension to include more cases under the Advance Authorization Scheme. About Advance Authorization Scheme The scheme is implemented by the Director General of Foreign Trade. It allows duty free import of inputs, which are physically incorporated in an export product. DGFT provides a sector-wise list of Standard Input-Output Norms (SION) under which the exporters may choose to apply. 	
Spice Board India	 Recently, Spice Board India at Kochi celebrated its 36th anniversary. Genesis - It is a statutory body constituted under Spice Board Act 1986 after merging erstwhile Cardamom Board and the Spices Export Promotion Council. Objective The board is responsible for development of the cardamom industry and promotion export of 52 scheduled spices listed under the act. Organisational Structure The board is headed by a senior secretary level officer. Also, two Members of Parliament are also elected to serve on the board. The board functions under administrative control of the Ministry of Commerce and Industries. 	
Sunflower oil	 Centre has discontinued TRQ (Tariff Rate Quota) for the import of crude sunflower seed oil for 2023-24. TRQ is a quota for a volume of imports that enter India at specified or nil duty. But after quota is reached, normal tariff applies to additional imports. India imports almost 85 per cent of Sunflower oil from Ukraine and Russia. 	
SWAYATT (Start-ups, Women and Youth Advantage Through eTransactions)	 A function was held to commemorate the success of "SWAYATT", an initiative on Government e-Marketplace (GeM). About SWAYATT: The initiative was first launched in 2019. It aims to promote inclusiveness of various categories of sellers and service providers on GeM portal. GeM has been setup (under administrative control of Ministry of Commerce and Industry) for procurement of goods and services by Central Ministries, State Departments, PSEs and Autonomous Bodies. 	





Air cooled condenser (ACC)	 NTPC has commissioned India's first Air cooled condenser (ACC) installed Super Critical plant at North Karanpura in Jharkhand. About Air cooled condenser (ACC): An ACC is a direct dry cooling system where steam is condensed inside air-cooled finned tubes. ACC has almost 1/3rd water footprint as compared to a conventional Water Cooled Condenser (WCC). This would result in water saving of around 30.5 mcm annually.
Defence Exercises	 Shinyuu Maitri: It is the exercise conducted between the Indian Air Force (IAF) Japan Air Self Defence Force (JASDF). DUSTLIK-2023: It is the exercise conducted between the Indian Army and Uzbekistan Army under a UN mandate.
National Institutes of Pharmaceutical Education and Research (NIPERs)	 Union Minister of Chemicals & Fertilizers, chairs the First Governing Council meeting of the of NIPERs. About NIPER It is an autonomous body established under the aegis of the Department of Pharmaceuticals, Ministry of Chemicals & Fertilizers. It is a Centre of Excellence for higher education, research, and development in pharmaceutical sciences. It has been declared an "Institute of National Importance" by an Act of Parliament.
Young professional scheme	 Recently, India decided to open applications for residents of the U.K to apply for the young professional scheme. About the scheme Under the scheme Indian and British nationals aged between 18 and 30 can apply to live and work in either country for a period of up to two years. It highlights the strength UK-India Mobility and Migration Partnership, signed in 2021. Criteria for application It requires an applicant to show funds equivalent to INR 2,50,000 held for a minimum period of 30 days at the time of submission of the application. Every professional coming to India is required to register with the Foreigners Regional Registration Office/Foreign Registration Office (FRRO/FRO).
Hubble Space Telescope (HST)	 HST has captured a Jelly fish Galaxy J0201 in Cetus Constellation. > Jelly Fish Galaxies are galaxies that exhibit long, thin, tentacle-like structures extending from their center. Gases are stripped from the galaxy by strong gravitational forces. HST was launched into low Earth orbit in 1990 by NASA and ESA (European Space Agency). > It is a space-based observatory that allows to observe universe in visible, ultraviolet, and near-infrared light spectrums.
Personality in news Image: Constraint of the second seco	 Shri Morarji Desai (29 February, 1896 - 28 July, 1979) Born in Gujarat, Morarji Desai joined the provincial civil service of Bombay in 1918. He served as a Deputy Collector for twelve years and in 1930 he joined Indian Freedom struggle under Mahatma Gandhi. > In 1931, he became a Member of All India Congress Committee. Post-independence, he served India in various capacities including as Prime Minister of India in 1977-79. > He received highest civilian award of India (Bharat Ratna) and of Pakistan (Nishan-e-Pakistan). Virtues: An outstanding administrator, he is known for virtues of truthfulness and strong conviction.
