

RESERVE BANK OF INDIA (RBI) RELEASED STATE FINANCES: A STUDY OF BUDGETS OF 2022-23 REPORT

- It is an annual publication that provides information, analysis and an assessment of finances of State governments for 2022-23.
- Theme of this year's Report is "Capital Formation in India The Role of States".
- Key findings of report
 - State's Gross fiscal deficit (GFD) is budgeted to decline to 3.4 percent of GDP in 2022-23 from 4.1 percent in 2020-21.
 - GFD is excess of total expenditure including loans net of recovery over revenue receipts (including external grants) and non-debt capital receipts.
 - > States' debt is budgeted to ease to 29.5 percent of GDP in 2022-23 as against 31.1 percent in 2020-21.
 - > In 2022-23, states have budgeted higher capital outlay than in previous three years.
- Recommendations
 - > Increase allocations of capital expenditure for sectors like health, education etc.
 - > Create a capex buffer fund during good times to smoothen and maintain expenditure quality and flows through economic cycle.
 - > Strengthen timely devolution mechanism to local bodies through State Finance Commissions.
 - > Encourage and facilitate higher inter-state trade and businesses.

ISRO'S VENUS MISSION SHUKRAYAAN- I COULD BE SHIFTED FROM 2024 TO 2031

- ISRO stated that it is yet to receive approval from Indian government for Venus mission, as a result mission may be delayed until 2031.
 - In 2031, Earth and Venus would be aligned in manner that it would require minimum amount of propellant for spacecraft to enter Venus orbit.
- Shukrayaan I will be an orbiter mission. Its scientific payloads include high-resolution synthetic aperture radar and ground-penetrating radar.
 - > Mission is expected to study Venus's geological and volcanic activity, emissions on ground, wind speed, cloud cover, and other planetary characteristics from an elliptical orbit.
- Mission Challenges: Venus has crushing air pressure at its surface, which is 90 times more than Earth's, and its atmosphere is highly toxic and filled with Sulphuric Acid that causes a powerful greenhouse effect.
- Other mission to Venus: Venera program (Russia); Akatsuki project (Japan); VERITAS i.e., Venus Emissivity, Radio Science, InSAR, Topography, and Spectroscopy, Mariner 2 and Magellan (NASA); EnVision mission (Europe) etc.
- Venus is second planet from Sun and sixth in solar system in size and mass.
- > Often referred to as Earth's twin. Both planets are almost alike in size, density and gravity.
- > At 850 degrees Fahrenheit, it is hottest planet in solar system.
- > It **rotates on its axis backward**, compared to most of other planets in solar system.



SOLITARY WAVE (SW)

- Indian scientists reported first evidence of **presence of SW in Martian magnetosphere** with help of data recorded by **MAVEN spacecraft of NASA.**
 - SW are Distinct electric field fluctuations (bipolar or monopolar) that follow constant amplitude-phase relations. Their shape and size are less affected during their propagation.
- Mars Atmosphere and Volatile Evolution (MAVEN) explore the Mars atmosphere, ionosphere and how they interact with Sun and solar wind.

CAPITAL FORMATION

- It refers to process by which **resources are invested in Assets** like plants, machinery etc. and **Human capital** through education, health, skill development etc.
- In 2021, India's capital investment/GDP ratio of 31.2 percent in 2021 is higher than other BRICS nations.

CENTRE SEEKS SEARCH PANEL FOR POSTINGS IN JUDICIARY

- Ministry Law and Justice has written to Chief Justice of India (CJI) expressing the need for Search-cum-Evaluation Committee (SEC) to bring transparency in judicial appointments through collegium system.
- SECs will be entrusted to prepare a panel of eligible candidates from which respective collegiums will make recommendations.
 - > A representative of Union government should be a member of SEC for appointment of judges in Supreme Court and chief justices of high courts.
 - > SECs for appointment of judges in high court should have a nominee of state government.
- At present, appointment mechanism as outlined in Memorandum of Procedure (MoP) does not include a SEC.
- > MoP is a crucial document that governs collegium system of appointing judges.
- CJI and Judges of SC are appointed by President under Article 124 (2) with the help of collegium system.
- Collegium system is the way by which judges of SC and HC are appointed and transferred.
 - > SC collegium is a five-member body, which is headed by incumbent CJI and comprises four other senior-most judges of court at that time.
 - >HC collegium is led by incumbent Chief Justice and two other senior-most judges of that court.

RBI RELEASES DISCUSSION PAPER ON EXPECTED LOSS (EL)-BASED APPROACH FOR LOAN LOSS **PROVISIONING BY BANKS**

- Provisioning for loan losses refers to the mechanism used recognise credit to impairments ensure to effective financial reporting and prudential supervision.
- Presently, banks are required to make loan loss provisions based on an 'incurred loss' approach, which used to be the standard globally till recently.

NEED TO REVIEW CURRENT APPROACH

- Current approach do not permit recognizing credit losses based on events that are expected to occur in future.
- Basel Committee supports an EL approach that captures actual losses more transparently.
- Delays in recognizing EL under an "incurred loss" approach was highlighted during Global financial crisis (2007-09).

> In short, banks need to provide for losses that have occurred / incurred.

- Expected Loss (EL)-based Approach
 - > Proposed approach is to formulate principle-based guidelines. Further, Regional rural banks and smaller cooperative banks are proposed to be kept out of the framework.
 - > Three-stage classification of financial assets (FAs) is envisaged i.e.,

Stage 1	 FAs that have not had a significant increase in credit risk. For these assets, 12-month expected credit losses are recognized. Interest revenue is calculated on gross carrying amount of asset. 	
Stage 2	 FAs that have had a significant increase in credit risk. For these assets, lifetime expected credit losses are recognized. Interest revenue is still calculated on gross carrying amount of asset. 	
Stage 3	 FAs that have objective evidence of impairment. For these assets, lifetime expected credit loss is recognized. Interest revenue is calculated on net carrying amount. 	

> Banks would be allowed to design and implement their own models for measuring expected credit losses for purpose of estimating loss provisions.

COLLEGIUM SYSTEM HAS EVOLVED WITH THREE JUDGES CASE

- First Judges Case, 1981 or S P Gupta Case: SC ruled that recommendation made by CJI to President can be refused for "cogent reasons", thereby giving greater say to executive.
- Second Judges Case, 1993 (Supreme Court Advocates on Record Association (SCARA) vs Union of India): CJI only need to consult two senior-most judges over judicial appointments and transfers.
- Third Judges Case, 1998: CJIs should consult with four senior-most SC judges to form his opinion on judicial appointments and transfers.

WORLD EMPLOYMENT ANN SOCIAL OUTLOOK: TRENDS **2023 REPORT RELEASED**

- It is an annual report of International Labour Organisation (ILO) that provides labour market projections for 2023 and 2024 and presents trends in labour productivity growth.
- Key findings
 - > Global employment will grow by just 1 percent in 2023, and global unemployment rate has been pegged at 5.8 percent.
 - > Emerging geopolitical tensions, recovery from pandemic, and issue in supply chains fuelled conditions for labour market deterioration.
 - > Labour force participation rate of women stood at 47.4 percent in 2022, compared with 72.3 percent for men.
 - In Asia and the Pacific and Latin America and the Caribbean, annual employment growth is projected to be around 1%.
- ILO is a specialized agency of United Nations headquartered in Geneva, Switzerland.
 - > It is the only tripartite U.N. agency that brings together governments, employers and workers of 187 member states to set labour standards for promoting decent work for all women and men.
 - > It was created in 1919 as part of Treaty of Versailles.
 - > It was awarded Noble Peace Prize 1969 for promoting fraternity among nations by ensuring social justice.
 - > Other reports released by ILO: Global Wage Report, and World Social Protection Report.

National Financial Reporting Authority (NFRA)	 NFRA has published draft requirements for auditors to prepare and publish annual transparency reports to increase transparency in management and governance of audit firms. NFRA was constituted in 2018 under section 132(1) of Companies Act, 2013. > It is an independent regulator to oversee auditing profession and accounting standards with jurisdiction extending to all listed companies and large unlisted companies. > It has same powers as a Civil Court while trying a suit. > It consists of a chairperson who will be appointed by Central Government and a maximum of 15 members.
Advance Traffic Management System (ATMS)	 National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) is implementing ATMS on highways to reduce accidents. ATMS is an integrated solution to manage highway traffic through real time information and ensure safety. ATMS has been implemented for around 3,000 km of National Highways. In case of commercial vehicles, system check for valid fitness certificate. NHAI is also looking at leveraging GIS technology for analysing drone videos and Network Survey Vehicle data for identifying safety issues on highway.
Survival of the Richest report by Oxfam International	 Key Findings related to India: Richest 1% in India now own more than 40% of country's total wealth and bottom half of the population together share just 3% of wealth. Female workers earned only 63 paise for every 1 rupee a male worker earned. Since the pandemic began till November 2022, billionaires wealth surged by 121%. Suggestions Introduce one-off solidarity wealth taxes and windfall taxes to end crisis profiteering. Permanent increase in taxes on richest 1% and especially raise taxes on capital gains.
Startup India Innovation Week	 Startup India Innovation week, organised by DPIIT, culminated with felicitation of Winners of National Startup Awards 2022 on National Startup Day. Awards acknowledges startups and enablers instrumental in revolutionizing development story of India and in demonstrating exceptional capabilities. ASCEND (Accelerating Startup Calibre & Entrepreneurial Drive) SAMAGAM event was conducted by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). Its objective was to capacitate and augment knowledge on entrepreneurship and continue efforts towards creating a robust startup ecosystem in Northeast.
Exercise Varuna	• It is a Bilateral Naval Exercise between India and France.
Katarnaighat Wildlife Sanctuary (KWS)	 Forest department of Katarniaghat division and NABARD planning to give skill-development training to Tharu people that live near KWS. Tharu People are ethnic group indigenous to Terai region of Himalayan foothills, located in southern Nepal. In India, they mostly lived in Utter Pradesh, Bihar, Uttarakhand. They speak various dialects of Tharu, a language of Indo-Aryan subgroup. KWS is situated in Upper Gangetic plain falling in Terai of Bahraich district, UP. It is part of core area of Dudhwa Tiger reserve. It provides strategic connectivity between tiger habitat of India and Nepal.
Geospatial Hackathon	 Department of Science and Technology has announced the Geospatial Hackathon. Hackathon seeks to promote innovative and cutting-edge solutions from India's start-up community as well as recognise research work that could be applied to solve geospatial issues. Aim to promote partnerships not only among public and private geospatial sectors but also to strengthen country's geospatial Start-Up ecosystem.



Exoplanets	 NASA stated that James Webb Space Telescope has discovered its first new exoplanet LHS 475 b. Exoplanets are planets that orbit other stars and are beyond our solar system. Most of exoplanets discovered so far are in a relatively small region of Milky Way Galaxy. Discovering exoplanets is tough as they are small and hard to spot around their bright host stars. Thus, scientists rely on indirect methods like transit method, which is measuring the dimming of a star that happens to have a planet pass in front of it.
International Health Regulations (IHR), 2005	 During first meeting of Working Group on amendments to IHR, India had proposed several amendments like: > Implement IHR in accordance with common but differentiated responsibilities of States Parties, taking into consideration their social and economic development. > Assess human health in congruence with animal and environment health to promote One Health. Working group is expected to submit its report by January 2024. IHR, 2005 is a legally binding agreement of 196 countries to build capability to detect and report potential public health emergencies worldwide. > IHR require that all countries have ability to detect, assess, report, and respond to public health events.
Personality in news	 Thiruvalluvar Thiruvalluvar Day observed on 15 January as a part of Pongal celebrations to mark his birth anniversary. He is also known as Valluvar. He was a Tamil poet-saint and philospher. It is belived that he was born in Mylapore, a neighbourhood in present-day Chennai and flourished between 4th century and 6th century. In early 16th century, a temple was built within Ekambareswarar temple complex in Mylapore and it was dedicated to Thiruvalluvar. In 1976, a temple-memorial called Valluvar Kotam was built in Chennai and houses one of largest auditoriums in Asia. 133-foot tall statue of Thiruvalluvar stands at Kanyakumari. He is best known for his work — Tirukkural, a collection of couplets on politics, love, ethics, and matters concerning economics. Personal Values: Hardworking, kindness, patience, ethical etc.
