# ATM in Train? Railway test India's 1st onboard ATM; Check All Details here

**Maharashtra:** The first automated teller machine (ATM) on a train in the nation successfully made its debut on Tuesday inside an air-conditioned coach of the Panchavati Express, which runs every day between Mumbai and Manmad in Nashik.

According to Indian Railways authorities, the test proceeded without incident, with the exception of a few instances in which the machine lost signal while the train traveled through a known no-network region between Igatpuri and Kasara, which also features tunnels.

## ATM in Trains

"The results were good," Bhusawal, the divisional railway manager, Ity Pandey, said. "Cash withdrawals aboard a moving train will soon be possible. We'll keep an eye on the machine's performance," he stated.

The ATM is a joint project of the Bank of Maharashtra and the Railways' Bhusawal division under the Innovative and Non-Fare Revenue Ideas Scheme (INFRIS). Pandey told the media that the idea of setting up an ATM on trains was first suggested during an INFRIS meeting held by the Bhusawal division. He added that as soon as the idea was shared, they quickly talked about how it could be made possible.

## Passengers Happy with this Initiative

On Tuesday, passengers on the Panchavati Express expressed their satisfaction with the availability of an ATM. Although the machine is located in an AC coach, it is easily accessible because vestibules connect the train's 22 coaches.

Sanjay Jha, a passenger, stated: "This is a commendable move by the Railways. Statements, checkbooks, and cash withdrawals are all available to the public. It will be really beneficial for the passengers."

## ATM Service May Expand to More Trains if Successful

The machine will also be accessible for long-distance passengers to Hingoli, outside of the

Manmad-Nashik route, as the Panchavati Express's rake is shared with the 12071 Mumbai–Hingoli Janshatabdi Express. Three rakes are shared by both trains.

According to officials, the onboard ATM service might be expanded to other important trains if it proves to be successful. Regarding security, the officials stated that the ATM is under 24-hour CCTV surveillance and can be closed.

# India Records World's Highest Number of Adoptions: Over 4,500 Children Adopted

According to the Ministry of Women and Child Development, India saw 4,515 child adoptions in FY 2024–2025, the most in the previous 12 years.

The Ministry stated that 4,155 of the total were domestic adoptions, indicating the nation's increasing acceptance of legal adoption.

## New Adoption Centres in India

Data from the Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA), which added 8,598 new children to the adoption pool, enabled this robust identification drive. CARA falls under the Ministry of Women and Child Development as a statutory entity.

The adoption procedure was also streamlined by the establishment of 245 new adoption agencies in collaboration with state governments.

## Training and Awareness Campaigns for Adoption

The Ministry credited the progress in adoption to awareness campaigns and special training efforts:

- CARA conducted 45 virtual training sessions.
- The sessions covered topics like adoption timelines, training of Child Welfare Committee (CWC) members, foster care, and counseling for adoptive parents and children.
- CARA also held in-person orientation programs in 12 states and union territories.

Additionally, from October 2024 to January 2025, CARA organized meetings with adoptive parents in collaboration with 16 states.

## Supreme Court Directives for Adoption

Following directions from the Supreme Court, CARA began a detailed identification program for children. Children were placed into five groups:

1. Orphans
2. Abandoned

3. Surrendered
4. Unfit guardians
5. Children without visitation

The Ministry stated that the goal of this strategic initiative was to ensure that more children would have access to a safe and nurturing home by bringing them into the legal adoption framework.

### **New Programs for Older Children**

Additionally, new programs were launched by CARA to improve alternative family-based care. To guarantee that older children are placed in family-based alternative care, CARA added foster care and foster adoption modules to the CARINGS portal in 2024.

### **Adoption in Just 3-4 Months**

To make the adoption process clearer and efficient, digital tools were used. The CARINGS portal now includes updates related to:

- Data correction and cleanup
- Adoption Regulations, 2022
- Faster processing of adoptions

Thanks to these updates, the time taken for processing in-country relative and stepparent adoptions was reduced to just 3–4 months.

# Katra-Srinagar Vande Bharat: Reach Srinagar in Just 3 Hours; Travel Time Reduced by Half

Prime Minister Narendra Modi will launch the first Vande Bharat train to Kashmir in April, according to media sources on March 31, 2025.

As per the railway authorities, Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate the Vande Bharat train, which will travel from Jammu to Srinagar via Katra district, on April 19. Modi is expected to visit the Udhampur area of Jammu and Kashmir.

## Reach Srinagar in Just 3 Hours

The Vande Bharat train from Katra to Srinagar will cut the travel time to just three hours. Railway officials mentioned that the current road journey takes around six to seven hours, making the train journey a much faster option for commuters.

The Vande Bharat Express will reduce travel time between Katra and Srinagar to just 3 hours, instead of the current 6-7 hours by road. Right now, trains run between Srinagar and Sangaldan. Once the railway line from Sangaldan to Katra is ready, these trains will be extended to Katra, said Northern Railway's Chief Public Relations Officer, Himanshu Shekhar Upadhyay.

## Srinagar Vande Bharat Special Features

The Kashmir Vande Bharat train is designed with special features to handle cold weather. It has advanced heating systems for freezing temperatures, and the driver's front window has built-in heating elements to prevent fogging and ensure clear visibility in harsh winters.

## Vande Bharat Express Katra-Srinagar Timings

The Vande Bharat Express train is scheduled to depart Katra at 8.10 am and arrive in Srinagar at 11.20 am. The train is scheduled to depart Srinagar at 8.55 am and arrive in Katra at 12.05 pm, according to railway authorities.

## **Vande Bharat to Cross Chenab Bridge: World's Tallest Rail Arch Bridge**

"The Sangaldan to Katra portion will now be operational, following the 25 km Udhampur-Katra section in 2014, the 18 km Banihal-Qazigund part in 2013, and the Banihal to Sangaldan section in 2023. This project includes Chenab Bridge, the tallest rail arch bridge in the world. Rail travel will be more pleasurable thanks to the tunnels, bridges, and valleys," as informed by railway officials.

## **Vande Bharat: India's First Semi-High Speed Train**

The Vande Bharat Express, India's first domestic semi-high-speed train, was introduced by Indian Railways and is considered a "Make in India" success story.

The first Vande Bharat Express train started its journey on February 15, 2019. It ran on the New Delhi-Kanpur-Allahabad-Varanasi route at a speed of 160 kilometers per hour.
