

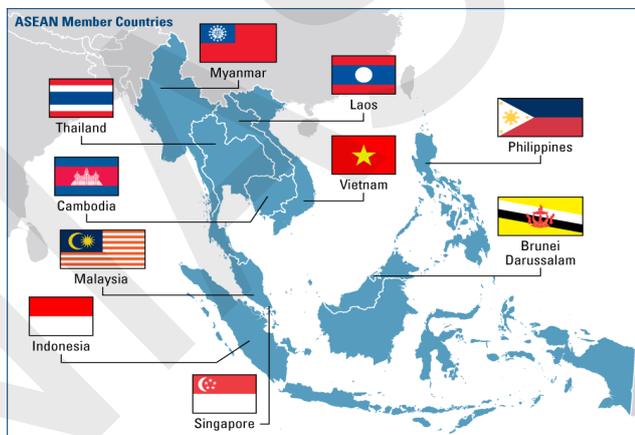

PRIME MINISTER ATTENDED 20TH ASEAN-INDIA SUMMIT AND 18TH EAST ASIA SUMMIT (EAS) IN JAKARTA, INDONESIA

• Key highlights of the Summits

➤ India presented a **12-point proposal** for strengthening India-ASEAN (Association of Southeast Asian Nations) cooperation, which includes:

- Establishing multi-modal connectivity and economic corridor **linking South-East Asia-India-West Asia-Europe.**
- Sharing **India's Digital Public Infrastructure Stack** with ASEAN Partners.
- **ASEAN-India Fund for Digital Future** focusing on cooperation in digital transformation and financial connectivity.
- Invitation to ASEAN countries to join the **Global Centre for Traditional Medicine and Coalition for Disaster Resilient Infrastructure.**
- Renewal of **support to the Economic and Research Institute of ASEAN and East Asia (ERIA)** to act as a knowledge partner
- Called for **enhanced cooperation on maritime safety, security and domain awareness.**



• ASEAN was established in 1967 with the signing of the Bangkok Declaration.

➤ ASEAN is **central to India's Act East policy**, which focuses on the extended neighbourhood in the Asia-Pacific region.

• EAS is a forum of **18 countries of the Asia-Pacific region** formed to further the objectives of regional peace, security and prosperity.

➤ EAS consists of **ten ASEAN Member States and Australia, China, India, Japan, New Zealand, South Korea, Russia and the USA.**

G20 POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ADVANCING FINANCIAL INCLUSION AND PRODUCTIVITY GAINS THROUGH DIGITAL PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE (DPI) REPORT

• The report has been prepared by the **World Bank** as an implementing partner of the **Global Partnership for Financial Inclusion (GPII)** under the G20 India Presidency.

• DPIs are generally understood as **interoperable, open, and accessible infrastructure** supported by technology to provide essential, society-wide, public and private services digitally such as identification, payments, and data exchange.

• Role of DPIs in advancing financial inclusion and productivity gains:

- **Sharing** of data **empowering** users to access tailored products
- **Enabling access** to credit and new markets
- Provide opportunities for innovation and **improved competitiveness**

• Risks for DPIs:

- **Operational risks** such as cybersecurity risks and spillover effects
- **Insolvency risks** in case of financial unsustainability of DPI providers
- **Exclusion risk** in case of poor design
- **Privacy risk** such as unauthorized retention, use or sharing of data

• Policy Recommendations:

- Enabling and fostering the **use of DPIs in accelerating financial inclusion;**
- **Develop well-designed DPIs** and the broader enabling environment through a widely accepted set of good practices.
- **Encourage appropriate risk-based regulation, supervision, and oversight arrangements** for financial sector use of DPIs.
- Promote **sound internal governance arrangements.**

GPII is an inclusive platform for **all G20 countries, interested non-G20 countries and relevant stakeholders** to carry forward work on **financial inclusion**, including implementation of the **G20 Financial Inclusion Action Plan**, endorsed at the G20 Summit in Seoul in 2010.

ASSETS WORTH OVER \$1.8 BILLION RECOVERED UNDER FUGITIVE ECONOMIC OFFENDERS ACT

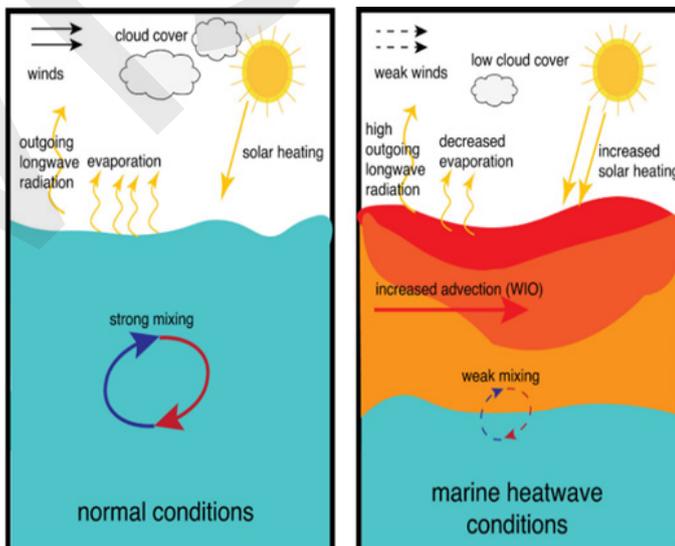
- A **Fugitive Economic Offender (FEO)** is a person against whom an **arrest warrant has been issued** for involvement in **economic offenses involving at least Rs. 100 crore** and the person **has left India to avoid criminal prosecution**.
- Presently, only 10 people have been declared as fugitive economic offenders.
- **FEO Act, 2018:**
 - **Scheduled Offences** are **counterfeiting government stamps** or currency, cheque dishonour, **transactions defrauding** creditors, **money laundering**, etc.
 - **Declaring an offender:** an application will be **filed in a Special Court** designated under the **Prevention of Money-Laundering Act, 2002**.
 - **Enforcement Directorate (ED)** is the **apex agency** to implement the law.
 - **Empower authorities** to **confiscate assets even** when **no conviction has been obtained**.
 - **Rights and titles of the confiscated property** vest in the central government.
 - **Appeals** against the **orders of the special court** will lie before the **High Court**.
- **Priority areas to deal with FEO:**
 - **Law enforcement cooperation** via information sharing,
 - **Strengthening asset recovery** mechanisms,
 - Enhancing the integrity and effectiveness of **anti-corruption authorities**.
- **Challenges:** Lack of international cooperation on deportation, **complex legal structures** of different countries and jurisdictions, etc.

WORLD METEOROLOGICAL ORGANIZATION FORECASTS MARINE HEATWAVES (MHW) MAY EXTEND TILL 2024

- **MHW** is an **extreme weather** event. It occurs when the **surface temperature** of a particular region of the **sea rises to 3 or 4 degrees Celsius** above the **average temperature for at least five days**.
- **Reasons for extended MHW**
 - **El Nino:** redistributing the upper ocean heat content **from west to east across the Pacific**.
 - **Negative phase of the North Atlantic Oscillation (NAO)** can **impact surface winds** and **influence ocean temperatures** causing heating of North Atlantic.
 - **Excessive heat absorbed** by the ocean, due to **rising Global warming** induced by human activities.
- **Impacts**
 - **Biodiversity and habitat loss:** Causes **heat stress on marine species** including foundation species like seagrass, kelp, and corals.
 - **Weather patterns:** In the tropical Indian Ocean, it will lead to **rapidly intensifying cyclones and fluctuations in the monsoon rainfall**.
 - **Economic loss:** Through increased mortality of economically important species such as fish etc.
 - **Increased ocean stressors:** like acidification, and deoxygenation.

- **El Niño** refers to **unusual warming of surface waters in the eastern tropical Pacific Ocean**.

- **Negative NAO** is a phase when both the sub-polar low and the subtropic high are weaker than average.



SCIENTISTS CREATED A MODEL OF HUMAN EMBRYO WITHOUT EGGS OR SPERM

- Scientists used **mix of stem cells** to **assemble them into an embryo-like structure**, mimicking **molecular characteristics** of an early **embryo stage**.
 - **Stem cells** are **fundamental building blocks** of human body, capable of generating all other cells with specialized functions.
- **Process of creating an embryo model**
 - **Stem cells were reprogrammed** to become any type of tissue in body.
 - Chemicals were **then used to coax** stem cells into becoming four types of cells **found in earliest stages of human embryo, viz.**
 - **Epiblast cells**, which become the embryo proper (or foetus).
 - **Trophoblast cells**, which become the placenta.
 - **Hypoblast cells**, which become the supportive yolk sac.
 - **Extraembryonic mesoderm cells**.
- **Implantation** of this model embryo is **not allowed** and will be **used for research only**.
- **Significance**
 - Assist in the study of the **earliest moments of human lives which is presently difficult to study after the embryo gets implanted in the uterus**.
 - Better understanding of **genetic, epigenetic, and environmental effects** on a developing embryo.
 - **Other:** test effect of **drugs on pregnancies**, improve success rates of **in vitro fertilization**, and assist in study of **transplant tissues and organs**, etc.

DRAFT GUIDELINES FOR PREVENTION AND REGULATION OF DARK PATTERNS RELEASED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS

- Dark patterns refer to **deceptive design patterns using UI/UX** (user interface/user experience) **interactions** on any platform.
 - It **mislead people into doing something they originally did not wish to do**, such as paying for items or services they did not intend to buy.
- **Key features of the draft guideline**
 - **Objective:** To **clearly identify and define tactics as dark patterns** so that the Ministry of Consumer Affairs **can act against platforms indulging in this under Section 18 of the Consumer Protection Act, 2019.**
 - **Applicable:** All platforms, systematically offering goods or services in India; Advertisers; Sellers.
 - **Prohibitions against engaging in dark patterns:** No person, including any platform, shall engage in any dark pattern.
 - Draft guidelines have **specified about 10 dark patterns**

Dark Patterns	Example
False urgency	Describing a sale as an 'exclusive' sale for a limited time.
Basket sneaking	Automatically adding travel insurance while a user purchases a flight ticket.
Confirm shaming	A platform for booking flight tickets using the phrase "I will stay unsecured", when a user does not include insurance in their cart.
Forced action	Forcing a user to subscribe to a newsletter in order to purchase a product.
Subscription trap	Making the process of cancellation of a paid subscription impossible or complex.
Interface interference	An 'X' icon on the top-right corner of a pop-up screen leading to the opening-up of another ad rather than closing it.
Bait and switch	The seller advertises low-cost, high-quality products. Moments before purchase, claims unavailability, substitutes with similar but costlier alternatives.
Drip pricing	The practice whereby elements of prices are not revealed upfront or are revealed surreptitiously within the user experience.
Disguised advertisement	Practice of posing, masking advertisements as other types of content such as user generated content or new articles or false advertisements.
Nagging	Websites asking a user to download their app, again and again.

Swachh Vayu Sarvekshan 2023 Rankings

- Swachh Vayu Sarvekshan is an **initiative by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF & CC).**
- It **ranks cities on the basis of the implementation of activities approved under city action plan** and air quality in 131 National Clean Air Programme cities.
- Cities are required to do the self-assessment as per the framework provided on the **PRANA online portal.**
- **Major Components of Assessment:** solid waste management, road dust management, etc.
- **First ranked cities:** Indore (million plus population), Amravati (3-10 lakhs population) and Parwanoo (less than 3 lakhs population).



Major security breach reported from Idukki Dam

- **Idukki dam**
 - It is a **double-curvature Arch dam constructed** across the Periyar River in Kerala.
 - It is the **third-highest arch dam in India** after the Tehri Dam (Uttarakhand) and Bhakra Nangal Dam (Himachal Pradesh).
 - It supports a **780 MW hydroelectric power station.**



Nairobi declaration

- **The first Africa Climate Summit 2023** ends with the 'Nairobi Declaration'.
- **Nairobi declaration** called for an **annual climate finance pledge of \$100bn** and reforms to **multilateral financial systems.**



Sanchi to soon be India's first 'solar city'

- **Sanchi town** lies in the Raisen District of Madhya Pradesh.
- It is known for its **Buddhist Monuments (Stupa)** which is also a **UNESCO world heritage site.**
- **Significance**
 - sits near the **Tropic of Cancer** makes it ideal for harnessing solar power.
 - **Help in reducing emissions** of more than 14,000 tonnes of carbon dioxide annually.

 <p>SLIM and XRISM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA) launched an H-2A rocket carrying the SLIM moon lander and the XRISM space telescope.SLIM (Smart Lander for Investigating Moon) will attempt to pull off Japan's first-ever soft lunar landing at Shioli Crater in early 2024.<ul style="list-style-type: none">It aims to demonstrate pinpoint-landing technology which can enable landing anywhere on the Moon.XRISM (X-Ray Imaging and Spectroscopy Mission) is a collaboration involving JAXA, NASA and the European Space Agency (ESA).<ul style="list-style-type: none">It will study the universe in high energy X-ray light from the Earth's orbit.
 <p>MQ 9 UAV</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">India requested the acquisition of 31 top-grade MQ-9B Reaper or Predator-B drones from the United States.Features of MQ9 UAV<ul style="list-style-type: none">Endurance of over 27 hours.Speeds of 240 KTAS (Knots true airspeed)Can operate up to 50,000 feet, and has a 3,850 pound (1746 kilogram) payload capacity.Drones are capable of a variety of roles, including maritime surveillance, anti-submarine warfare, over-the-horizon targeting, airborne early warning, electronic warfare.
 <p>Gati Shakti Vishwavidyalaya (GSV)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">GSV is a Central University in Vadodara (Gujarat), established through an Act of Parliament in 2022.It is India's first University in the Transportation and Logistics sectors.It subsumes the previously-existing National Rail and Transportation Institute (NRTI).Sponsored by the Ministry of Railways.Mandate: applied education, training, skilling, and research in logistic sector.
 <p>Cheriyal Scroll painting</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Cheriyal Scroll paintings are unique to Telangana, having Geographical Indication (GI) status.<ul style="list-style-type: none">It is a popular and modified version of Nakashi art, highly rich in local motifs.Features:<ul style="list-style-type: none">Painted in narrative format and depict stories from Indian mythology as well as shorter stories related to the Puranas and Epics.Use in story-telling by the balladeer community called Kaki Padagollu.Painted in mostly primary colors, showing a predominance of red color in the background.
 <p>Military Exercise BRIGHT STAR- 23</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Bright Star 23 is a multilateral U.S. Central Command exercise held in Egypt. India participated in this exercise for the first time.
